### **Local Road and Street Finance Questionnaire Instructions**

This questionnaire is a summary of local receipts and expenditures for all roads and streets under your jurisdiction. Please report all receipts and expenditures related to: (1) the construction, maintenance, operation, and administration of roads, streets, alleys, and other public ways; (2) traffic police and road patrols; and (3) debt service and status of bonds and notes issued to finance highway activities.

Some categories may require coordination with other governmental agencies. If you cannot provide a firm figure for any data item, please give an estimate.

Private sector donations for roads and streets under local government jurisdiction should be included on the questionnaire.

Local governments may use either cash or an accrual accounting method in reporting information to the NDOR.
