

Local Transportation Enhancement Projects Scheduled for FY-2006[#]

The Nebraska Enhancement Program provides funding to local, regional and state government entities to construct and restore transportation facilities that are not eligible for funding through other programs. Examples of projects that would be eligible include trails, development of scenic byways, restoration of historic transportation facilities and other projects directly related to the historic, current, or future transportation infrastructure. Projects require at least a 20% match by the local governmental entity. The following shows the total estimated cost per project.
