- 2. The bid item "Performance Graded Binder (64-22)" has been added as a bid item with a quantity of 178.740 Ton.

The EBS generated bid items sheet must show these corrections <u>or the bid will be</u> considered void.

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On page 19 of the Special Provisions, in the provision titled PERFORMANCE GRADED BINDER, the first paragraph in the section titled "I. Description" is amended to read:

The performance graded binder to be used on this project shall be PG Binder 64-22, supplied by a Certified Supplier.

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The Special Provisions are amended to include the following:

SUPERPAVE ASPHALTIC CONCRETE (S5-6-1201)

Asphaltic Concrete shall meet all specifications and be sampled and tested as shown in the Supplemental Specifications. Table 1028.18 of the Supplemental Specifications incentive - disincentive pay factors do not apply, however, any asphaltic concrete air void tests resulting in a 50% or reject pay factor as listed in the table will be subject to removal.

Paragraph 2.b. (2) of Subsection 503.06 of the Supplemental Specifications is void and superseded by the following:

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For each sublot of Asphaltic Concrete Type SP1, SP2, SP3, SP4 and SP5, the asphaltic concrete unit price is multiplied by the average density per lot pay factor for the item "Asphaltic Concrete Type _____".

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Upon execution of the contract, the plans will be revised to reflect this change.
