



I-80 eastbound traffic will be moved to the newly completed bridge on Thursday,
February 3. The traffic change will take place between 9:00 p.m., Thursday and 6:00 a.m.,
Friday.

On Monday, February 7, westbound I-80 will be moved to the median on I-80. This will allow for the construction of the westbound bridge. This change will take place between 9:00 p.m., Monday and 6:00 a.m., Tuesday. During striping operations related to this change, the westbound entrance ramp from Cornhusker Highway will be temporarily closed.

Cornhusker Highway, westbound, will be closed Tuesday early morning, February 8, from midnight until 6:00 a.m., to allow for the removal of the I-80 westbound bridge.

Railroad Rules Approved for Highway-Rail Safety

The Nebraska Department of Roads announces the adoption of the approved Railroad Rules & Regulations. These Railroad Rules & Regulations implement the Nebraska Highway-Rail Grade Crossing Safety Act, LB-255 (1997), Nebraska Revised Statutes 74-1329 through 74-1343. This Act includes the Administration of State and Federal Highway-Rail Grade Crossing Safety Projects; Highway-Rail Crossings-Construction, Repair and Maintenance; and the Comprehensive Public Safety Program for Highway-Rail Grade Crossings.

The Railroad Rules & Regulations were approved by Governor Johanns on December 9, 2004, and became effective December 14, 2004.

The Department of Roads is distributing information on the Rules & Regulations to operating railroads in Nebraska, the League of Nebraska Municipalities, the Nebraska Association of County Officials, as well as other interested parties. As part of the project, about 1 mile of U.S. 75 will be widened to accommodate a center turning lane, from just south of the Bureau of Indian Affairs access road to the roundabout intersection.

Construction will be done under traffic without need of a detour. Traffic will be routed on temporary roadways around work zones during some phases of construction.

Construction may impact wetlands areas and mitigation may be required. Replacement wetlands would be established on public right-of-way along the project or at a regional wetlands banksite
