A Final Environmental Impact Statement for Project DPS-34-7(114), known as the Plattsmouth Bridge Study, has been signed by the Federal Highway Administration and has been filed with the United States Environmental Protection Agency.

The report discusses the Missouri River Bridge between Cass County, Nebraska, at Plattsmouth, and Mills County, Iowa. The existing bridge is recognized as a historic bridge.
